RE: Request for permission from Department of Financial Services to write-off the 2005 Regulatory Assessment Fees, plus accumulated penalty and interest, due from Loch Harbour Utilities, Inc., pursuant to Order No. PSC-10-0172-WU, issued March 25, 2010, in Docket No. 060332-WS.

The Public Service Commission, through Order No. PSC-10-0172-FOF-WU, issued March 25, 2010, has determined that reasonable collection efforts have been made to collect from Loch Harbour Utilities, Inc., the Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) for the year 2005, plus penalty and interest, and that further efforts to collect from the utility would not be cost effective:

The Commission specifically noted that the utility had abandoned operations and the County had taken over operations as of November 2005, and that no response had been received from the utility despite several staff inquiries about payment of the RAFs. Therefore, in accordance with Order No. PSC-10-0172-FOF-WU, please proceed to seek approval from the Florida Department of Financial Services to write off the uncollected 2005 RAFs, fines, penalties, and interest as uncollectible.
