Re: Verizon Florida's Revised Response to the 2010 Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier (ILEC) Local Competition Data Request

Dear Ms. Cole:

Attached is a copy of Verizon Florida's revised response to the Commission's annual ILEC data request. This filing includes a separate envelope containing a confidential CD with the revised data table responses.

This revised filing is being made in response to staff's follow-up e-mail of April 20, 2010. Staff noted that the total numbers for Tables 1, 3, and 4 did not coincide with the FCC form 477 Part II.A. Verizon has determined the causes of the variances between these tables and the Form 477 data:

- Table 1 includes FX-FGA-WATS lines; the Form 477 does not.
- Table 3 includes EELs but excludes Unknown CLECs, while the 477 excludes EELs but retains the Unknown CLECs. MCI is excluded from both Table 3 and the 477.
- Table 4 excludes Unknown lines; the Form 477 does not.

A note is included on each of the tables to explain these variances.

Table 1, we are not able to distinguish which lines are served over fiber, so a NPA-NXX breakdown doesn't exist. Those two columns have been updated as "not available."

For Tables 2 and 4, staff's requested changes have been incorporated.

On Table 5, staff requested an NPA-NXX and "Res" or "Bus" breakdown. All FiOS digital voice lines are residential; however, a breakdown by NPA-NXX or exchange does not exist.

This claim of confidentiality was filed by or on behalf of a "telco" for Confidential DN 03560-10. The document is in locked storage pending advise on handling.
