2	CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Let's move on to Item 2.
3	Ms. Beard?
4	MS. BEARD: Good morning, Commissioners.
5	Catherine Beard on behalf of Staff.
6	Item Number 2 addresses Virgin Mobile's
7	request for designation as an eligible
8	telecommunications carrier in Florida. Virgin Mobile's
9	Lifeline offering includes a free E911 compliant handset
10	and 200 minutes of free air time each month.
11	Staff would like to make two minor factual
12	corrections to the recommendation. The first one is
13	located in the last sentence on Page 6. The words
14	"resale services" should be changed to "its own
15	facilities."
16	CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: I'm sorry. Would you
17	repeat the change?
18	MS. BEARD: Sure. The words "resale
19	services"
20	CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Uh-huh.
21	MS. BEARD: should be changed to "its own
22	facilities."
23	CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Okay.
24	MS. BEARD: And the second correction is
25	located in the last bullet on the bottom of Page 11.
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1The cost of additional minutes should be changed from 202cents to 10 cents, and the cost of text messages should3be changed from 10 cents to 15 cents. In addition to4those modifications, TracFone withdrew its comments in5opposition on May 14th.6With us this morning to discuss this item, we7have Susan Clark representing Virgin Mobile and Earl

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11 CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Thank you. Commissioner12 Skop, do you have a question?

13 COMMISSIONER SKOP: I'll just reserve the14 question.

CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Okay. Ms. Clark?

MS. CLARK: Thank you, Madam Chairman andCommissioners.

As Staff has indicated, I am Susan Clark. I am with the law firm of Radey, Thomas, Yon & Clark, and I am here today on behalf of Virgin Mobile USA, whose petition for limited designation as an ETC carrier is before you as proposed agency action.

I would also like to introduce Mr. Peter Lurie, who is Senior Vice President for Sprint; and next to him is Mr. Doug Nelson, who is a regulatory attorney

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with Sprint.

We support Staff's revised recommendation to 2 grant Virgin Mobile's petition and allow it to make 3 prepaid wireless services available in Florida. We 4 appreciate the Staff's hard work and agree with their 5 analysis, and we respectfully request that you adopt the 6 7 recommendation. We are happy to answer any questions you may 8 9 have. CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Thank you. 10 Commissioners? Commissioner Skop. 11 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Madam Chair. 12 13 This is a question to Staff. On Page 13 of Staff recommendation in the 14 Conclusions section, second paragraph, it states, "If 15 Virgin Mobile should decide in the future to seek 16 high-cost universal service fines, it should be required 17 to file a petition to make a showing that it would be in 18 the public interest to grant such a request." 19 If you look further down on the page, it says, 20 "Granting the ETC designation should be contingent on 21 Virgin Mobile providing the following". I don't see any 22 express language that addresses Staff concerns within 23 those bullets. 24 So is it proper within the order to expressly 25

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state that if they seek high-cost universal service 1 fines in the future that they would be required, 2 commiserate with the order, to come back in? 3 MR. CASEY: We can certainly do that to 4 clarify it. 5 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. Because that's, 6 7 like I say, it's a notation made by Staff, but it's not reflected in the bulleted list of the requirements. 8 9 And just one final question, with respect to the comparison, I guess it looks like TracFone has 10 withdrawn its comments. But under the existing Virgin 11 Mobile offering for Lifeline, it seems that customers 12 13 will be -- or will receive 200 anytime minutes per month at no charge and those minutes will not roll over; 14 15 that's correct? 16 MS. BEARD: Correct. 17 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. And under the existing TracFone program, I think they get 68 minutes 18 but those minutes do roll over? 19 MS. BEARD: Correct. 20 21 COMMISSIONER SKOP: All right, thank you. CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Mr. Poucher? 22 23 MR. POUCHER: Earl Poucher; Office of Public Counsel. 24 25 We're here to support Staff; good FOR THE RECORD REPORTING TALLAHASSEE FL 850.222.5491

recommendation. We're anxious to see Virgin Mobile come to Florida. And there are some folks in Sopchoppy who will take advantage. CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Commissioners, any comments? Do we have a motion? COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Madam Chair. With respect to the disposition of Item 2, I'd move to approve the Staff recommendation on Issues 1 and 2, noting that TracFone has withdrawn its comments. CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Do I have a second? COMMISSIONER KLEMENT: Second. CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: All those in favor, say Aye. (Vote Taken.) MS. BEARD: Thank you, Commissioners. CHAIRMAN ARGENZIANO: Thank you very much.
