On May 17, 2010, AT&T Florida requested additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Gainesville exchange (Main DS1) (GSVLFLMADS1) switch. AT&T requested a 10 K block of numbers from NANPA, specifically for 10,000 consecutive numbers in the format of 352-NX4-XXXX) to meet the request of a customer to meet its dialing patterns. On May 21, 2010, AT&T's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust and utilization criteria.

On May 25, 2010, AT&T filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NANPA's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the AT&T petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (June 14, 2010), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NANPA should be directed to provide AT&T the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Gainesville exchange (Main DS1) (GSVLFLMADS1) switch. Please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Jim Polk at (850) 413-6510.
