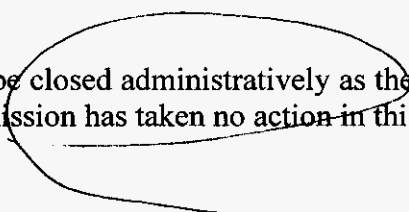

On February 5, 2010, dPi Teleconnect, LLC ("dPi") filed its Petition for Supplemental ETC Authority with the Florida Public Service Commission in Docket No. 100071-TP (the "Supplemental Petition"). Subsequent to the filing of the Supplemental Petition, in the course of conducting market research throughout the region, dPi has determined that the Florida market is not a good fit for dPi's wireless business plan at this particular time due to the high penetration level of wireless services by other carriers in the State of Florida.
