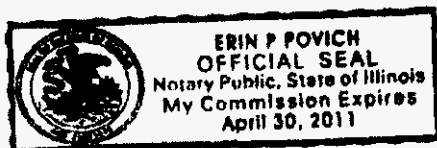



**CUSTOMER NOTICE**

**ISSUED: July 20, 2010**

On September 29, 2009, Utilities, Inc. of Longwood (the "Utility"), completed its application to the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for increased wastewater service rates, in which it requested a permanent rate increase for its wastewater system in Seminole County of 26.74%.

By Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-10-0407-PAA-SU ("PAA Order"), issued June 21, 2010 in Docket No. 090381-SU, the Commission approved a rate increase of 6.61% for wastewater service. In addition, the Commission approved revised miscellaneous service charges and non-sufficient funds check charges. These rates and charges were designed to allow the Utility the opportunity to recover its reasonable and prudent costs for providing service, and a reasonable rate of return on its investment in facilities necessary to provide such wastewater service. The PAA Order was not protested within the protest period, and became final by Order No. PSC-10-0456-CO-WS, issued July 16, 2010.

The increased rates and charges are effective for service on or after July 26, 2010.

The rates prior to filing, the Commission-approved wastewater rates, and approved revised miscellaneous service charges are attached to this customer notice.

This notice was prepared by the Utility and approved by the Commission Staff for distribution by the Utility to its customers.

**NSF CHECK CHARGES**

The Commission has also approved NSF Check charges that may be levied consistent with Section 68.065 and Section 832.08(5), Florida Statutes, when a customer pays by check and that check is dishonored by the customer's banking institution. The Company will charge the amount set by Section 68.065 and Section 832.08(5), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. As currently set forth in Section 832.08(5), the following fees may be assessed:

- 1) \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50,
- 2) \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300,
- 3) \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300,
- 4) or five percent (5%) of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.
