On December 4, 2009, Sanlando Utilities Corporation (the "Utility"), completed its application to the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for increased water and wastewater service rates, in which it requested a permanent increase for its water system in Seminole County of 14.52% and a permanent increase for its wastewater system in Seminole County of 16.36%

By Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-10-0423-PAA-WS ("PAA Order"), issued July 1, 2010, the Commission approved a 4.23% rate decrease for water service and an increase of 15.19% for wastewater service. In addition, the Commission approved non-sufficient funds check charges. These rates and charges were designed to allow the Utility the opportunity to recover its reasonable and prudent costs for providing service, and a reasonable rate of return on its investment in facilities necessary to provide such water and wastewater service. The PAA Order was not protested within the protest period, and became final by Order No. PSC-10-0472-CO-WS, issued July 27, 2010.

The increased rates and charges are effective for service on or after August 15, 2010.

The rates prior to filing, the Commission-approved water and wastewater rates, and approved non-sufficient funds check charges are attached to this customer notice.
