Dear Ms. Cole:

Pursuant to Rule 25-9.044(1), Florida Administrative Code, please accept this letter as notification that on August 6, 2010, Florida Public Utilities Company (herein "FPUC")(GU603 and EI803), an affiliate of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation, consummated a corporate transaction with Indiantown Gas Company (GU606), whereby FPUC acquired all of the natural gas assets held by Indiantown Gas Company via an asset purchase agreement. Indiantown Gas Company has retained its existing propane assets.

While FPUC will own and operate the newly acquired natural gas facilities under the "Florida Public Utilities Company" name, customers served by the former Indiantown Gas Company facilities will continue to receive service under the tariffed rates, rules, and classifications currently on file with the Commission for Indiantown Gas Company. To the extent required by Rule 25-9.044, Florida Administrative Code, FPUC will

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
