REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION PROVIDED IN RESPONSE TO STAFF'S SEVENTH SET OF INTERROGATORIES

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information provided in response to Staff's Seventh Set of Interrogatories, No. 99 ("Confidential Discovery Response") which was served by Staff on September 27, 2010. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

1. FPL served its responses to Staff's Seventh Set of Interrogatories on October 18, 2010, for overnight delivery to Staff on October 19, 2010. This request is being filed contemporaneously with the service of the responses to Staff, in order to request confidential classification of the Confidential Discovery Response consistent with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

2. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:

a. Exhibit A consists of a copy of the Confidential Discovery Response on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted.

b. Exhibit B consists of an edited version of Exhibit A on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.

Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A, together with references to the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.

d. Exhibit D is the affidavit of Gerard J. Yupp, Senior Director of Wholesale Operations for FPL, in support of this Request.

3. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determined that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the hard of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

4. As the affidavit included in Exhibit D indicates, the information provided by FPL contains information concerning negotiated rates related to Florida Gas Transmission's Phase VIII expansion project. This information relates to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of FPL's counterparties. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e).

5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information provided in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibits B, C, and D is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See S.366.093(4)*, F.S.

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WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of the Confidential

Discovery Responses as described herein.
