According to AT&T, the information is proprietary and confidential business information that AT&T seeks to keep confidentially pursuant to Section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)

Based upon my review the information meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, F.S., and should be treated as confidential.

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- On October 11, 2010, AT&T filed in the above-captioned proceedings, its
 Responses to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Staff's") First Request for
 Production of Documents (Nos. 1-37). The document produced in response to Item No. 19,
 contains confidential business information that is considered by AT&T to be proprietary.
- 2. AT&T hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information contained in above-listed material contains confidential traffic flow and volume data that are deemed proprietary by AT&T. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.
