**Re: Docket No. 100065-SU - Application for certificate to provide wastewater service in Monroe County by Venture Out at Cudjoe Cay, Inc.**

Dear Mayor Murphy:

The Florida Public Service Commission is in receipt of your September 20, 2010 letter of objection to the issuance of original wastewater certificate to Venture Out at Cudjoe Cay, Inc. (Venture Out). In your letter, you state that Monroe County objects to the issuance of a certificate to Venture Out, but you did not request an administrative hearing before the Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.567, Florida Statutes. I need to understand whether you are requesting a hearing or whether your letter of objection is for purposes of informing the Commission of Monroe County's concerns regarding the issuance of a wastewater certificate to Venture Out.

If a governmental agency merely objects to the issuance of the certificate, the letter of objection is placed in the docket file here at the Commission, and remains available for review and informational purposes. If a governmental agency timely objects to the issuance of a certificate and requests a hearing, that government agency becomes a party to the proceeding and is entitled to a full evidentiary hearing before the Commission. The utility will also be a party to the proceeding. If Monroe County chooses to ask for a hearing, it will have certain rights and responsibilities to put forward its case, including filing written testimony, participating in motion practice and formal discovery, and attending the hearing where Monroe County's witnesses would possibly be subject to cross-examination.

Staff has determined that Venture Out is an exempt entity under Commission statutes and has provided a recommendation to the Commission. That recommendation is attached. The Commission will consider staff's recommendation, and presentations by Venture Out or other interested persons, including Monroe County, at its November 9, 2010 Commission Conference. If Monroe County is sending a representative, please contact me in advance.


