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CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Item Number 15.

MR. FLETCHER: Commissioners, I'm Bart Fletcher with Commission Staff.

Item 15 is Staff's recommendation to suspend the final requested rates of Tradewinds Utility, Inc., and to approve the interim rate increases subject to refund with interest.

Staff has an oral modification which has been previously provided to the Commissioners and all parties, and Staff is prepared to answer any questions the Commission may have.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: To the board.

Commissioner Skop.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you. And I appreciate Staff for making the oral modification there on the record.

Just recapping the proposed action here, which I believe is the increase shown for interim revenue increase on page 4 represents a 61.35 percent increase for water and a 9.92 percent increase for wastewater; is that correct?

MR. FLETCHER: That's correct.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. And in terms of the

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projected customer bill, looking at the page 17 of the Staff recommendation and page 18 of the Staff recommendation under Staff recommended interim rates, for water under a 5/8ths residential meter for consumption of 5,000 gallons on a monthly basis it looks like the bill is going from \$17.14 up to Staff recommended interim rates of 27.95, \$27.95 for water?

MR. FLETCHER: That's correct, Commissioner, for water.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. And then, and then for wastewater on page 18, going, using that same analysis for the 5,000 gallons, going from approximately \$48.66 to \$53.51 on an interim basis. And it seems as if the final rates, if approved, ultimately approved by the Commission would be somewhat higher; is that correct?

MR. FLETCHER: That is correct. Pardon me.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. So then I guess the, the issue between water and wastewater for average consumption for a household, give or take a little, it seems as if the monthly water and wastewater bill is going to be approximately \$80 a month, is that generally correct, adding the 5,000 gallons wastewater for the interim rates to the 5,000 gallons of water, somewhere around there?

MR. FLETCHER: That is correct. It would be approximately \$80 for a total water and wastewater bill service.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. And are there any other consent orders or anything in place in terms of this utility or DEP actions pending?

MR. FLETCHER: I'm not aware of any in their filing. They are required to file consent orders within their minimum filing requirements and I have not seen any.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. All right. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commissioner Balbis.

wanted to confirm the discussion I had with Staff earlier on this item, and just for the record at least, you know, it was something that I had questioned that really our hands are tied with these interim rate increases until, you know, we can go through the full determination on the rate case. So I just wanted to point that out for the record it's something that, you know, I had discussions with Staff, and I'd just like confirmation for that, or of that.

MR. FLETCHER: That is correct, Commissioner.
We -- it's addressed on page 4 of the recommendation,

where in the interim statute it says that once the 1 Utility has made a prima facie showing within the four 2 corners of their petition, then provision 2(a) of the 3 interim statute kicks in where the Commission shall 4 bring them up to the minimum of their last authorized 5 rate of return within 60 days of their filing. 6 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Okay. Thank you. 7 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any further discussion? Can 8 9 I get a motion? COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Move Staff. 10 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and seconded 11 to move Staff recommendation.
