2 ~~(1) All records that a utility is required to keep, by reason of these or other rules~~
3 ~~prescribed by the Commission, shall be kept at the office or offices of the utility within this~~
4 ~~State, unless otherwise authorized by the Commission. Such records shall be open for~~
5 ~~inspection by authorized representatives of the Commission at any and all reasonable hours.~~

11 ~~(1) Bills shall be rendered at regular intervals and shall show at least the billing period~~
12 ~~covered; identification of the applicable rate schedule; the amount of the bill and, as~~
13 ~~applicable, gross and/or net billing, and/or discount or penalty, and final discount or penalty~~
14 ~~date. When there is good reason for doing so, estimated bills may be submitted. If bill is~~
15 ~~estimated, it shall be so marked.~~

16 ~~(2) Whenever for any reason the period of service for which a bill is rendered is less~~
17 ~~than fifty percent (50%) of the normal billing period, the charges applicable to such service,~~
18 ~~including minimum charges, shall be pro-rated in the proportion that the actual number of~~

20 ~~(a) Opening bills need not be rendered but may be carried over to and included in the~~
21 ~~next regular monthly billing.~~

22 ~~(b) For service taken under flat rate schedules, fifty percent (50%) of the normal~~

24 ~~(c) The practices employed by the utility in this regard shall have uniform application~~
25 ~~to all customers.~~
