**PETITIONERS' RESPONSE TO RESPONDENTS' OPPOSITIONS TO
RECONSIDERATION**

Petitioners hereby reiterate as a matter of fact overlooked at February 8, 2011 Hearing, this matter was not fully heard according to law. Despite at that time the request to *rebut* Respondents' inaccurate statements, the incorrect assumption exists that Petitioner seeks to *re-argue* the stated position on record. Further, as a matter of fact overlooked, Commission reached its decision based on a flawed Staff Memorandum that fails to meet Standard of Review. As a matter of law failed to be considered by Commission, Commissioners are yet to act according to law, including Florida Statutes 202.16, 202.125 and 203.013(5) referenced in prior pleadings. Subsequent to the same day issued "Commission Vote Sheet" referencing Commissioners' non impartial judgment, the procedurally and substantively sufficient Notice and Motion for Reconsideration was filed, that reconsideration of this matter is appropriate.
