Document No. 11319-08 is a staff recommendation that included confidential information in it on pages 15 and 21. Document No 00133-09, (Order No. PSC-09-0024-FOF-EI) cites the same information as found in Document No. 11319-08. The information contained in these documents came from discovery responses filed by Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) on July 21, 2008 (See Document No. 06271-08).

Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, FPL requested confidential classification of Document No. 06271-08. This request was granted by Order No. PSC-08-0743-CFO-EI, issued November 6, 2008. On November 8, 2010, Document No 06271-08 was returned to FPL.

On February 9, 2011, John Butler, Managing Attorney for FPL, contacted Erik Saylor, staff attorney, to state that "due to the passage of time, FPL no longer needs to designate as confidential . . . [the information in] Document Nos. 11319-08 and 00133-09." The full text of the e-mail message from Mr. Butler is attached to this memo. (See Attachment A)

Accordingly, please take the necessary steps to "declassify" Document Nos. 11319-08 and 00133-09.
