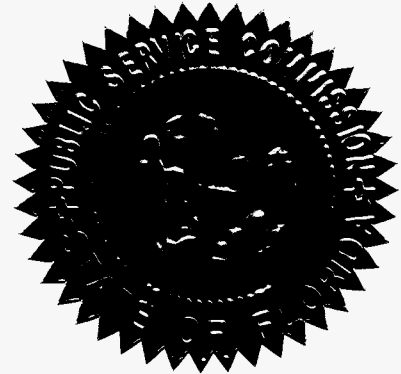

1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Okay. Item Number 5.

3 **MS. ROBERTS:** Good morning, again,
4 Commissioners. Arlisha Roberts with Commission
5 staff.

6 Item 5 is FPL's request and petition for
7 approval to add an approval Residential Service
8 Dynamic Price Response Pilot Rate to their -- offer
9 it to their customers. We're bringing this -- this
10 is a suspend rec that we're bringing so that staff
11 can have additional time to analyze and do the
12 investigations needed in order to provide staff --
13 the Commission with an appropriate recommendation.
14 We also have the company here, and staff can answer
15 any questions that you may have.

16 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Okay.

17 Ms. Cano.

18 **MS. CANO:** Good morning. Jessica Cano on
19 behalf of Florida Power and Light Company, and I am
20 simply here to answer any questions you may have.

21 Thank you.

22 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Just one of you today,
23 huh? Do you think you can handle this?

24 **MS. CANO:** I'm going to do my best.

25 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** All right, let's bring

1 it back here to the board. Any questions?

2 Commissioner Balbis.

3 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Thank you, Mr.
4 Chair.

5 We have a short agenda, so we can't finish
6 too quickly here.

7 I was wondering from FPL, I'd like just a
8 real brief explanation of this program, and then
9 follow up with just one more question after that.

10 **MS. CANO:** Sure.

11 This is a pilot project that is intended
12 to study the economic merit, customer acceptance,
13 and technical feasibility of a combination of both
14 technologies and rates. There's actually three
15 different types of technologies that will be tested.

16 Two of them are different types of in-home energy
17 usage display systems. One of those has the
18 capability to actually control appliances, heating
19 and cooling, and pool pumps. And the third type of
20 technology is actually a very small group of
21 participants will receive particular appliances, and
22 that is in combination with two different types of
23 rates.

24 Some of the customers will stay on our
25 standard RS-1 service rate, and the others will

1 actually participate in this proposed rate that is
2 the subject of our petition in this case. And that
3 rate is a combination. It's called a dynamic price
4 rate. It's a combination of lower prices for most
5 of the time, and a much higher price during critical
6 peak periods with the goal being to drive down usage
7 during those times.

8 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Thank you.

9 And I did notice there is \$200 million in
10 ARRA funding for this, and there's a -- I don't want
11 to say significant, but there was a staff data
12 request issued on February 15th, and I know with
13 those grants there is usually a time frame
14 associated with it. Will the suspension and the
15 additional time needed to respond, will that in any
16 way risk those funds?

17 **MS. CANO:** A slight delay is not a concern
18 to us at this point in time, you know, a few more
19 weeks, a month, or something like that. But the
20 goal is to have participants enrolled by the summer
21 so that we can have a full year's worth of data. So
22 at this point, we are not concerned with this delay.

23 **COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Okay. Thank you.

24 I have no further questions.

25 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Commissioner Edgar.

1 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Thank you, Mr.
2 Chairman.

3 Which just brings back, I think, the
4 natural next question to staff which is when would
5 you expect that this item would be back before us
6 with additional information and analysis?

7 **MS. ROBERTS:** We have an outstanding data
8 request that is due back to us on the 14th. Once we
9 get that information, if all of the questions have
10 been answered and are sufficient and we feel like we
11 have enough information where we can go forth with a
12 recommendation, we'll bring one back to the first
13 upcoming agenda, after we receive it back. So as
14 soon as possible.

15 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Does that mean April,
16 maybe?

17 **MS. ROBERTS:** Yes.

18 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Okay.

19 And, obviously, to FPL, the expectation is
20 that the information given to our staff will enable
21 them to do what they need to do so that we can try
22 to meet those timelines?

23 **MS. CANO:** Yes, we are attempting to do
24 so, and we actually also plan to provide our
25 responses earlier, to the extent possible.

1 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Great. I look
2 forward to seeing the additional information. It
3 sounds like a very interesting and promising
4 program, but obviously we need to look at the
5 details.

6 Thank you.

7 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Was that a motion?

8 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** And I would move that
9 we accept the staff recommendation.

10 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** It has been moved and
11 seconded to accepted the staff recommendation on
12 Item Number 5. Any further discussion?

13 Seeing none, all in favor say aye.

14 (Vote taken.)

15 **CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Those opposed?

16 By your action you have approved Item
17 Number 5.
