AFFIDAVIT OF WILLIAM L. YEAGER


BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared William L. Yeager who, being first duly sworn deposes and says:

1. My name is William L. Yeager. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") as Vice President Engineering & Construction. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. I have reviewed the information included in Exhibit A to FPL's Request for Confidential Classification. The information in Exhibit A which is asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information relates to the competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the business of FPL. Specifically, the information relates to the terms and conditions of the warranty that FPL has negotiated for the ESPs to be installed on the 800 MW oil-fired units. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of the information in Exhibit A which is asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information.


3. Consistent with the provisions of the Florida Administrative Code, such information should remain confidential for the period of eighteen (18) months. In addition, the document containing the proprietary confidential business information should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business so that FPL can continue to maintain the confidentiality of that information.

4. Affiant says nothing further.

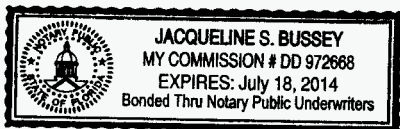
