**PROGRESS ENERGY FLORIDA, INC.'S MOTION TO DEFER MAY 19 FILING AND
MAY 23 STATUS CONFERENCE**

Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("PEF or the "Company") hereby moves to defer the May 19, 2011 status update filing and the May 23, 2011 status conference set in this docket. In support of this motion, PEF states as follows:

1. On April 26, 2011, the Pre-Hearing Officer in this matter issued Order No. PSC-11-0208-PCO-EI denying PEF's Motion to Bifurcate this proceeding. In that order, the Pre-Hearing Officer stated that:

I find that it is premature to make a decision on bifurcation of this proceeding. A status conference will be held on May 23, 2011...No later than May 19, 2011, PEF shall file an updated status report in this docket. The report shall include: a description of how far along PEF is in its engineering analysis of the second delamination event; a best estimate of the time it will take to complete the engineering analysis of the second delamination event; a best estimate of the time it will take to complete the engineering analysis; a current best estimate of the time it will take to bring CR3 back into commercial service; and a discussion of PEF's ability to satisfy its projected loads using existing capacity resources.

2. PEF has commissioned an engineering study of potential repair options and is analyzing that study. PEF expects to complete that analysis in June. Once that analysis is complete, PEF will be in a position to provide the Commission and the parties to this docket a detailed status report consistent with the Pre-Hearing Officer's April 26th Order. Specifically, once PEF has completed its analysis, PEF will be able to discuss possible options available to address the second delamination and PEF would further be able to provide informed

estimates on the timeframes associated with those options. Additionally, PEF would be in a position to discuss how each of the possible options impact PEF's ability to meet load demands with existing capacity resources once PEF has informed estimates of the timeframes associated with those options.


3. For these reasons, PEF respectfully requests that the Pre-Hearing Officer defer the May 19, 2011 status filing and the May 23, 2011 status conference. PEF further requests that it be allowed to file a status report with the Commission on June 27, 2011 that contains all the information required in the May 19, 2011 status filing. PEF would then be available to participate in a status conference on any date thereafter as the Commission may see fit.

4. The presiding officer has the authority to issue any order necessary to effectuate discovery, to prevent delay, and to promote the just, speedy, and inexpensive determination of all aspects of the case. *See* Rule 28-106.211, F.A.C.

5. Pursuant to Rule 28-106.204(3), F.A.C., PEF has conferred or attempted to confer with all parties of record and is authorized to represent the following: OPC takes no position on this motion. PEF was unable to obtain FIPUG's and PCS Phosphate's positions on this motion prior to filing.

WHEREFORE, PEF respectfully moves for the Commission to enter an Order granting this Motion.


