We the residents of Lake Osborne Estates (LOE) in unincorporated Lake Worth (FL), and within the Utility Service Area of Aqua Utilities Florida (AUF), respectfully petition the Commission for the relief of "predatory" pricing of necessary and sole-source water resources and for a roll back of the previous rate increase which doubled our rate over what a Lake Worth resident pays for the same water.

COMMISSION CLERK

Many homeowners are unable to afford to maintain their property with appropriate irrigation (and other water needs) leaving them in violation of Palm Beach County landscape codes and placing them in a precarious financial position. Further, due to drought conditions in (LOE), we are 8 inches below normal rainfall as well as suffering high unemployment and home foreclosures in this small bedroom community.

Now AUF has petitioned you for another massive increase in water rates in the amount of 33-55% less than a year and a half after doubling our rate. As you are aware, AUF is not a primary provider of water resources, but a reseller of water from a neighboring municipality, in which they already enjoy a 100% mark-up (via the 2009 rate increase). An additional increase would render this community financially distressed.

According to your website, the role of the FPSC is a commitment to make sure that Florida's consumers receive some of their most essential services...water...in a safe, *affordable* and reliable manner. Not only is any increase in pricing at this time *unaffordable*, we respectfully request that you consider our 'unique' circumstances, and roll back the previous doubling of our rates that is creating so much hardship in our community, and deny any further rate increases now proposed by AUF for Lake Osborne Estates. And, we request that a discussion of Parity rates be included in the decision making process as we believe Parity is a sound and reasonable path to the establishment of fair and equitable rates that are *affordable*.
