**Re: Docket No. 110091-EU – Petition for Approval of Renewable Energy Tariff and Standard Offer Contract by Florida Power & Light Company (FPL)**

Dear Mr. Hoffman:

In a letter to Ms. Ann Cole dated May 25, 2011, counsel for FPL stated that "FPL also is in the process of assessing its long term generation needs in a more detailed fashion. This work, which has not been concluded, will ultimately determine whether FPL's next planned generating unit will be required in 2016 or 2017." The letter also states that "FPL intends to complete its analysis to determine if the 2016 or 2017 avoided unit is appropriate within the next two (2) months." Based on the letter, FPL's analysis should be completed by the end of July 2011.

Per our conversation today, I understand that FPL is still on track to have its analysis completed by the end of July 2011, in conformance with the above mentioned letter. Given this timeline, I would expect revisions to the above mentioned Petition to be filed in early August, if needed. If this schedule were to change, please notify me as soon as possible so that Commission staff can determine how to proceed with FPL's current Petition.
