On April 1, 2011, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") submitted its Petition for Approval of a Renewable Energy Tariff and Standard Offer Contract ("Petition"). By letter dated May 25, 2011, and filed in the above referenced docket, FPL notified the Commission that it was in the process of assessing its long term generation needs in a more detailed fashion. FPL further stated that upon completion of FPL's ongoing analysis of its next planned generating unit, FPL would notify the Commission as to whether the avoided unit would be 2016 or 2017 and make any revisions to the tariff and standard offer contract filed with the Petition as appropriate.

FPL hereby notifies the Commission that it has completed this analysis, and FPL's avoided unit will remain 2016 as stated in the Petition based on FPL's most current assessment and information available. As a result, FPL will make no further revisions to this Petition and the proposed tariff and standard offer contract at this time. FPL would ask that the Commission approve FPL's tariff and standard offer contract as proposed in the Petition.
