
Re: Docket No. 110018-EU – Joint Petition for Need Determination between Solid

Dear Ms. Cole:

By letter dated May 24, 2011, and filed in the above referenced docket, FPL notified the Commission that it was in the process of assessing its long term generation needs in a more detailed fashion. FPL further stated that upon completion of FPL’s ongoing analysis of its next planned generating unit, FPL would determine whether the avoided unit, *i.e.*, next planned generating unit, would be in 2016 or 2017.

FPL hereby notifies the Commission that it has completed this analysis, and FPL’s avoided unit will remain 2016 based on FPL’s most current assessment and information available. FPL represents that the proposed purchase power contract between FPL and SWA in this docket was priced based on a 2016 FPL avoided unit.
