Dear Ms. Carter Brown:

On August 18 and 19, 2011, you contacted Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) to request information regarding Clay Electric Cooperative's (Clay) knowledge of FPL and Starke's Joint Petition for Territorial Agreement, which is before the Commission in this docket. On September 27, 2007, Clay entered into a territorial agreement with the City of Starke. At the time of negotiations between Clay and Starke, FPL was also negotiating a territorial agreement with the City of Starke. Both FPL and Clay have been, and remain, aware of each other's negotiations with the City of Starke. Additionally, in response to your request, on August 18, 2011, David Cobb, FPL's External Affairs Manager, confirmed with Herman Dyal, Director of Engineering for Clay, that Clay has no concerns with the proposed FPL/Starke agreement.

Finally, let me respond to your question regarding the duplication of services between FPL and Clay. As I advised in our call on August 19, FPL and Clay do have a few feeders that cross each other. There are no overlapping service locations or disputes about service, but FPL is mindful of your comments regarding a potential territorial agreement with Clay.
