**FLORIDA SOLAR ENERGY INDUSTRY ASSOCIATION'S

Florida Solar Energy Industry Association (FlaSEIA), pursuant to Order No. PSC11-0136-PCO-EG, issued on February 28, 2011, files its Prehearing Statement and states as follows:

**D. Statement of Basic Position:**

Order PSC-09-0855-FOF-EG, issued on December 30, 2009, approved funding of \$24.5 million annually for the five years from 2010 to 2014 to develop and implement solar pilot programs for all of the investor-owned utilities subject to the Florida Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act (FEECA): Florida Power & Light Company (FPL), Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (PEF), Tampa Electric Company (TECO), Gulf Power Company (Gulf Power) and Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC). The Commission subsequently approved specific solar pilot programs for each FEECA utility.

In order to ensure that each FEECA utility's ratepayers receive the maximum benefit from the approved solar pilot programs, each FEECA utility must fully commit, correctly allocate and timely distribute the approved solar pilot program funds.
