

PREHEARING STATEMENT

Pursuant to the requirements of the Order on Procedure, Order No. PSC-11-0120-PCO-GU, Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC") hereby submits its Prehearing Statement.

A. Known Witnesses

Florida Public Utilities intends to offer the direct testimony of Curtis D. Young dated May 3, 2011, as well as the testimony of Cheryl M. Martin, dated September 14, 2011.

C. Basic Position

FPUC has appropriately calculated its true-up amounts and purchased gas adjustment factor as shown in the Company's positions on Issues 1-6.

D. - F. Issues

FPUC's positions on the issues identified by Staff are as follows:

Issue 1: What are the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2010 through December 2010?

FPUC: An under-recovery of \$2,562,014.

Issue 2: What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2011 through December 2011?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$2,151,001.

Issue 3: What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period January 2012 through December 2012?

FPUC: An under-recovery of \$411,013.

Issue 4: What are the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2012 through December 2012?

FPUC: The appropriate PGA factor is 79.064 cents per therm, which includes additional capacity costs included in the Company's 2012 projections and reflecting anticipated additional upstream supply and capacity to serve new customers in 2012 in Nassau County.

Issue 5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

FPUC: The factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2012 and should apply for bills rendered for meter readings taken between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012.

Issue 6: What changes, if any, should be made to improve the reporting mechanism related to monthly PGA reporting as established in Order No. 24463?

FPUC: FPUC agrees with Commission Staff's preliminary position that invoices need not be submitted, but merely retained for audit purposes. FPUC also agrees that elimination of the monthly flex down notice would be appropriate.


