Dear Ms. Cole:

As we discussed yesterday, the page numbers which your office assigned to the record on appeal do not match the page numbers of the electronic filing. Pursuant to your suggestion, I have attached the first page from three of the 14 volumes as shown by the index, and I have noted the electronic filing page number on each one to show the difference. The basic problem is that the record has not been consecutively numbered as required by Rule 9.200(d)(1)(B) of the Appellate Rules.

The index shows 2,806 pages, but the actual record as electronically filed and numbered by the 1st DCA consists of 8,529 pages. None of the page numbers match the electronic filing, so it will be all but impossible for me or any of the other counsel to prepare a brief which must cite and refer the Court to specific pages as shown in the electronic record.

To solve this problem, I would suggest:

(1) That the entire record be renumbered consecutively, and that the 4 volumes of hearing transcript shown as "Attachment One" should be placed at the end as the last 4 volumes. Each volume that replaces "Attachment One" should include an index as to the exhibits in that volume. The index should include a reference to the first page of each exhibit. The parties and the Appellate Court personnel

should not have to search through thousands of pages to locate a particular exhibit. This should include each cover sheet and each index, although I do not see the point of including the entire index with each volume. The index with each volume should include only an index of what is in that volume. The overall index should be included once and it should also be consecutively numbered.

- (2) That the documents included as "Attachment Three" and "Attachment Two" should be included after what is now shown as Volume 14. These would be additional volumes not to exceed 200 pages each. All of the documents in those additional volumes should be consecutively numbered so that the numbers shown on each document page will match the numbers shown in the electronic filing.
- (3) Rule 9.200(d)(1)(A) says that the transcript (Attachment One) "shall be incorporated at the end of the record, and shall not be renumbered by the clerk." I would not suggest that you renumber the transcript pages, but I do suggest that you provide supplemental numbers in sequence after the rest of the record so there will be some way for counsel and others to refer to a page of the transcript as shown in the electronic filing.

This is simply my suggestion to solve the problem. The main point is to prepare the record so the entire record, now 8,529 pages, is numbered consecutively page by page and divided into separate volumes not to exceed 200 pages each.

Please feel free to call me if we need to discuss this matter further. If possible, I would like an opportunity to review the revised record before it is refiled.


