

AMENDMENT TO PETITION OF FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF ITS LEVELIZED FUEL COST RECOVERY FACTORS AND CAPACITY COST RECOVERY FACTORS FOR JANUARY 2012 THROUGH DECEMBER 2012

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby petitions the Commission for approval of revised capacity cost recovery ("CCR") cost projections for the period January 2012 through December 2012. FPL is revising the CCR cost projections that were filed on September 1, 2011 to account for the nuclear cost recovery amount approved for FPL by the Commission's vote at the October 24, 2011 agenda conference in Docket No. 110009-EI. In all other respects, the requests for relief stated in FPL's petition filed on September 1, 2011 in this docket remain the same. In support of this petition amendment, FPL incorporates the prepared testimony of T.J. Keith and accompanying Exhibit TJK-10 and states as follows:

1. The 2012 CCR cost projections and resulting CCR factors that FPL proposed on September 1, 2011 reflected recovery of a nuclear cost recovery amount of \$196,092,631. At the October 24, 2011 agenda conference, the Commission reduced the overall recovery amount by \$3,807, from \$196,092,631 to \$196,088,824. FPL is accordingly revising its proposed CCR cost projections in this docket to reflect the reduced nuclear cost recovery amount. Due to the small size of the change in the approved nuclear cost recovery amount, the 2012 CCR factors based on the revised amount do not change from those filed with Mr. Keith's September 1, 2011 testimony. The minor change affects only pages 5 and 7 of the CCR schedules for the period January 2012 through December 2012 in Appendix V (Exhibit TJK-8) to Mr. Keith's September 1, 2011 testimony. Revised pages 5 and 7 comprise Mr. Keith's Exhibit TJK-10, which is being filed with this petition.

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WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Company's amended CCR cost projections for the period January 2012 through December 2012 as set forth in the testimony of T.J. Keith and accompanying Exhibit TJK-10. In all other respects, the requests for relief stated in FPL's petition filed on September 1, 2011 in this docket remain the same.

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
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
