MR. FLETCHER: That is correct. If the Commission decides in its PAA decision that interim refunds are required, they will be refunded with interest. COMMISSIONER BALBIS: And with that, I move staff's recommendation on all the issues on this item. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It has been moved and seconded, staff recommendations on Item Number 11.
