Request to Assign a Separate Commission Document Number to AT&T Florida's Pricing Proposal.

Dear Ms. Cole:

On December 22, 2011, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida filed its Response to the Commission's Request for Proposal To Provide a Telecommunications Relay Service for Deaf, Hard of hearing, Deaf/Blind of Speech Impaired. As noted in the cover letter for AT&T's Response [FPSC Document No. 09118-11], AT&T filed:

- 1) An original and fifteen (15) copies of AT&T Florida's Response to the RFP
- 2) Five (5) copies of AT&T Florida's Pricing Proposal.

In addition, and as also noted in the cover letter [FPSC Document No. 09118-11], AT&T filed four (4) additional documents that are components of AT&T Florida's response to the RFP:

- 1) CA Initial Training Modules and Participant Guides
- 2) CA Manual (Position Tool)
- 3) CA Observation Form
- 4) Emergency Action Plan

These four component documents were separately filed with a claim of confidentiality

 pursuant Rule 26-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code [FPSC Document No. 09116-11]. In addition, AT&T Florida's Pricing Proposal was filed and identified as a confidential document covered by the same request for confidentiality [FPSC Document No. 09116-11]. It is not clear from the Commission's document index listing for the instant docket, but it appears that the Commission has filed and identified both the four component documents and AT&T Florida's Pricing Proposal as a single document for internal document tracking purposes under FPSC Document Number 09117-11.

Identifying the four component documents and Pricing Proposal with a single Commission document number has apparently created some confusion regarding the ability of the technical evaluators to review the four component documents in the course of the evaluation of technical portion of AT&T Florida's RFP. To resolve the confusion, AT&T Florida asks that the Commission identify the AT&T Florida Pricing Proposal with a new and different document number in document index listing for the instant docket. AT&T Florida would note that the request for confidentiality for the Pricing Proposal set forth in Document No, 09116-11 would remain applicable to AT&T Florida's Pricing Proposal.
