**ORDER GRANTING MOTION BY DEBTOR AND

This matter having come before this Court on the *Motion by Debtor And Debtor-in-Possession For Entry of Order Fixing Bar Date And Approving Form of Notice* (the "Motion")² and this Court having reviewed the Motion; and this Court having determined that the legal and factual bases establish just cause for the relief granted in this order;

THIS COURT HEREBY FINDS THAT:

A. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, venue of this case and this Motion in this district is proper under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409, and this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).

B. Service of the Motion was appropriate.

expedite the administration of the Debtor's estate and is in the best interest of creditors and parties in interest.

NOW THEREFORE, taking into consideration the foregoing findings and all of the evidence before the Court, it is **HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Motion is hereby GRANTED.
2. The bar date for the filing of any and all pre-petition claims is February 29, 2012 (the "Bar Date").
3. The Bar Date shall apply to any and all Claims by all entities, including but not limited to, individuals, partnerships, corporations, estates, trusts and governmental units, wherever located.
4. The Bar Date shall apply to all Claims against the Debtor that arose prior to October 9, 2011.
5. The holders of the following Claims are not required to file a proof of Claim on or before the Bar Date:
 1. Any Claim allowed by order of the Court entered on or prior to the Bar Date;
 2. Any Claim arising against the Debtor after October 9, 2011;
 3. Any Claim arising from the rejection of an unexpired lease or executory contract, in which case the holder of the Claim shall file a proof of claim by the later of (a) the Bar Date, and (b) thirty days after the entry of an order authorizing the rejection of the unexpired lease or executory contract;
 4. Any Claim identified as liquidated, noncontingent and undisputed in the Schedules; and
 5. Any Claim newly listed as contingent, unliquidated or disputed in any amendment to the Schedules filed after the date of this motion,

in which case the holder of the Claim shall file a proof of claim by the later of (a) the Bar Date, and (b) thirty days following the filing of the amended schedules.

6. If the holder of a Claim against the Debtor is required to file a proof of claim on or before the Bar Date but fails to do so: (a) such holder will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting its Claim against the Debtor (or filing a proof of claim with respect thereto), (b) the Debtor and its property will be forever discharged from any and all indebtedness or liability with respect to such Claim, (c) such holder will be barred from voting to accept or reject any chapter 11 plan or participate in any distribution in the Debtor's chapter 11 case or in any subsequent Chapter 7 case on account of such Claim, and (d) the Debtor not be required to provide such holder with further notices with respect to such Claim.

7. The form of notice attached as Exhibit A to the Motion (the "Notice") is approved in its entirety.

8. The manner of service of the Notice proposed in the Motion is approved.

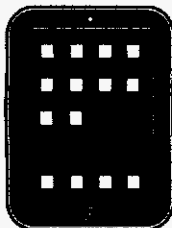
