# AT&T FLORIDA'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On February 14, 2012, AT&T Florida served its *Supplemental* Responses to Express Phone Service, Inc.'s ("Express Phone") First Request for Production of Documents Nos. 2, 3, 7 and 8, dated January 24, 2012.
- 2. AT&T Florida's responses to Express Phone's First Request for Production of Documents Nos. 2, 3, 7 and 8 contain information that is considered confidential and proprietary as it contains AT&T company policies and policy development information. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.
- 3. The information discussed in the Request for Specified Confidential Classification is confidential to AT&T Florida and related to its competitive interests. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.



- 4. Attachment A to AT&T's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated as confidential.
- 5. Attachment B to AT&T's Request for Confidential Classification is two redacted copies of the documents.
- 6. Attachment C to AT&T's Request for Confidential Classification is a highlighted copy of the document containing the confidential information.
- 7. The original of this Request was filed today with the Office of the Commission Clerk and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, AT&T Florida respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
