Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0436(3)(b), Gulf Power Company respectfully requests approval for a new depreciable class and rate for automobiles. Gulf Power is purchasing two (2) Ford Fiesta vehicles and expects to take delivery of the vehicles in April 2012.

A total projected cost to be incurred by Gulf Power is approximately \$15,000 per vehicle that will be recorded in FERC account 392-4110, Automobiles. Gulf Power plans to depreciate this investment over a 7-year life.
