RE: Docket No. 110319-TP - Request for approval of interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement between Embarq Florida, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink and QuantumShift Communications, Inc.

By letter received December 14, 2011, Embarq Florida, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink filed a petition for approval of the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement with QuantumShift Communications, Inc. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was March 13, 2012.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on March 22, 2012. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.d of the Administrative Procedures Manual. Therefore, it has gone into effect by operation of law in accordance with Section 252(e)(4) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
