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## PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Good afternoon. I'd like to call the prehearing for Docket No. 110087 to order.

Staff, could you please read the notice.

MS. TAN: Pursuant to notice, this time and place has been set for a Prehearing Conference in Docket No. 110087-TP.

commissioner Balbis: Okay. Thank you. And now I'd like to take appearances. We'll start with Express Phone.

MS. KAUFMAN: Good afternoon, Commissioner
Balbis. Vicki Gordon Kaufman of the law firm Keefe,
Anchors, Gordon & Moyle. I am here on behalf of Express
Phone Service, Inc.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Thank you.

And AT&T?

MR. HATCH: Tracy Hatch appearing on behalf of AT&T Florida. Also appearing with me is Suzanne Montgomery.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: And staff?

MS. TAN: Lee Eng Tan on behalf of Commission staff.

MS. HELTON: And Mary Anne Helton, advisor to the Commission.

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COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Thank you. 1 And, Ms. Tan, are there any preliminary 2 matters that we need to address before we get to the 3 Draft Prehearing Order? 4 MS. TAN: No, there's not. 5 COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. At this point I'd 6 like to go through the Draft Prehearing Order starting 7 with each section. And I'll give everyone an 8 opportunity to please stop me and raise any concerns 9 that you may have. 10 So starting with Section I, the case 11 12 background. Seeing none, we'll move on to conduct of 13 proceedings, Section II. 14 Seeing none, Section III, jurisdiction. 15 Section IV, procedure for handling 16 confidential information. 17 Section V, prefiled testimony and exhibits; 18 19 witnesses. Section VI, order of witnesses. 20 Section VII, basic positions. 21 Section VIII, issues and positions. 22 Section IX, exhibit list. 23 MS. TAN: Commissioner, staff is in the 24 process of preparing a Comprehensive Exhibit List 25

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consisting of all the prefiled exhibits in discovery. 1 Staff will provide the exhibit list to parties as soon 2 as possible. 3 In addition, staff has prepared a cover sheet 4 that it would like the parties to use for any additional 5 exhibits at the hearing, and staff will pass out sample 6 7 copies now to the parties. COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Thank you. Does 8 9 anyone have objections to that? Seeing none --10 MS. KAUFMAN: Excuse me, Commissioner. 11 Oh, sorry. COMMISSIONER BALBIS: 12 MS. KAUFMAN: I don't have any objections, but 13 until we see the list of the exhibits --14 COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. 15 MS. KAUFMAN: -- we'd want to reserve our 16 right to object at that time. 17 COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. That is noted. 18 MR. HATCH: Are you going to prenumber that 19 20 list? MS. TAN: Yes. 21 COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Any other 22 comments or concerns about Section IX, the exhibit list? 23 Okay. Moving on to Section X, proposed 24 stipulations. 25

Section XI, pending motions. 1 Section XII, pending confidentiality motions. 2 MS. TAN: Commissioner, there are four pending 3 confidentiality requests which will be addressed by 4 separate order. 5 MS. KAUFMAN: And, Commissioner, I would just 6 like to note that Express Phone did file an exhibit that 7 they -- that belongs to AT&T which we thought might be 8 confidential, and I understand AT&T believes that it is. 9 So they will be filing the appropriate documentation to 10 address that. It's actually attached to Mr. Armstrong's 11 testimony, who is our witness. 12 MR. HATCH: I believe that's the fourth 13 request for confidentiality that Ms. Eng [sic] referred 14 15 to. COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. And I don't 16 recall seeing that yet. 17 MR. HATCH: We filed, we filed it on Friday. 18 COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Okay. Any other 19 questions or concerns on Section XII? 20 Seeing none, we'll move on to Section XIII, 21 objections to qualifications to witnesses. 22 Moving on to Section XIV, post-hearing 23 procedures. 24 Section XV, rulings. 25

MS. TAN: Commissioner, staff would suggest that if there are any opening statements in this docket, that it should be limited to five minutes per party.

MS. KAUFMAN: I would ask that that amount of time be increased to ten minutes. We have very few witnesses, only two, and we're doing direct and rebuttal together. And I think that this case is one that there's a lot of legal and policy issues entwined with it, and I think it would be helpful to have a little more than five minutes for the opening statement. And Express Phone would intend to make an opening statement.

MR. HATCH: That's fine with us. At this point we had not intended on making either an opening or closing statement. But to the extent that Express Phone does, then we would reserve the right to do so as well.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Hearing no objections and the fact that they're not planning on opening statements, then I'm inclined to grant a ten-minute limit for opening statements.

Okay. Are there any other matters to address in this Prehearing Conference?

MS. TAN: There are no other matters.

MS. KAUFMAN: The only other thing I would mention is that I had talked to counsel for AT&T about maybe stipulating some of the witnesses. And, of

course, if that does happen, we'll let staff counsel know about that so that you'll be aware and the other Commissioners will be aware and ask for their permission.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Do you anticipate possibly stipulating all of the witnesses?

MS. KAUFMAN: I do not, no, not for Express Phone.

**COMMISSIONER BALBIS:** Okay. I mean, one of the things that I've done in a previous docket is if all, all witnesses are stipulated to, have one comprehensive witness in case the Commissioners or others have questions at the hearing. But given that there probably will be witnesses available, then I'll just keep that in my back pocket just so everyone knows. I think that was somewhat successful.

And are there any other matters? Seeing none, I want to thank the parties for being flexible with the scheduling. I do appreciate that. And seeing no other matters, this prehearing is adjourned.
