Pursuant to our recent conversation regarding Labrador Utilities', attorneys attempt to misrepresent the conclusions and recommendations contained within our July 2, 2011 report on the odor issues at Forest Lake Estates, I would like to reiterate our conclusion that;

"...Based on our review, we find there is overwhelming evidence that the operations of the wastewater – collection, treatment, and disposal LUI-operated facility that serve Forest Lake Estates have the potential to generate significant malodorous conditions in the community..."

The report additionally went on to specifically recommend that a comprehensive odor control evaluation and improvement project is needed to mitigate the odor issues and provided an overview of specific improvements to Labrador's wastewater facility infrastructure regarding the reduction of odors.
