As you are probably aware, the First District Court of Appeals issued its "Per Curiam Affirmed." of Order No. PSC-11-0010-SC-WU on May 15, 2012. Rule 25-30.436(6), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), provides as follows:

(6) Within 60 days after the issuance of a final order entered in response to an application for increased rates, or, if applicable, within 60 days after the issuance of an order entered in response to a motion for reconsideration of the final order, each utility shall submit a breakdown of actual rate case expense incurred, in total, in a manner consistent with Schedule No. B-10 (PSC/ECR Form 19-W or 20-W, whichever is applicable, as described in Rule 25-30.437, F.A.C.). If the deadline prescribed above cannot be met, an extension shall be granted by the Director of the Division of Economic Regulation for good cause shown.

Please provide the required information by no later than July 16, 2012. If you cannot provide the information required by Rule 25-30.436(6), F.A.C., by July 16, 2012, please request an extension of time and state the reasons and justification for such extension. If you have any
