Staff has completed the review of FPL's June 15, 2012 Request for Confidential Classification of staff's *Review of Florida Power & Light Company's Project Management Internal Controls for Nuclear Plant Uprate and Construction Projects*. Exhibit C of the request accurately reflects appropriate rationale for claiming the requested portions of the report confidential under Florida Statute 366.093(3), with one exception.

Staff believes that on page 41, line 5, the word "of" is not confidential. Staff recommends that the word "of" remains unredacted.

Staff has discussed its position and recommendation relative to page, 41, line 5 with FPL and the company has agreed with the exception.
