**WELLINGTON A HOMEOWNERS ASSOC., INC.'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S MOTION TO DISMISS**

Wellington A Homeowners Assoc., Inc. ("HOA"), pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby moves for an extension of time, through and including August 10, 2012, to file its response to Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL")'s motion to dismiss, Dismiss Wellington's Amended Complaint. In support of dismissal, Wellington states:

1. On May 14, 2012, this Commission entered an order requiring Wellington HOA to amend its complaint within 30 days to include a more definite statement; it did so on June 13, 2012.
2. On July 11, 2012, FPL filed its motion to dismiss the Amended Complaint.
3. Pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, HOA must file its response to FPL's motion to dismiss by July 18, 2012.
4. Due to preexisting scheduling conflicts, HOA requires a reasonable extension of time through and including August 10, 2012, to file its responsive pleading.
5. HOA conferred with counsel for FPL who has consented to the relief requested.
6. No party will be prejudiced by this extension.

WHEREFORE, Wellington HOA respectfully requests an extension of time through August 10, 2012 to respond to FPL's motion to dismiss.
