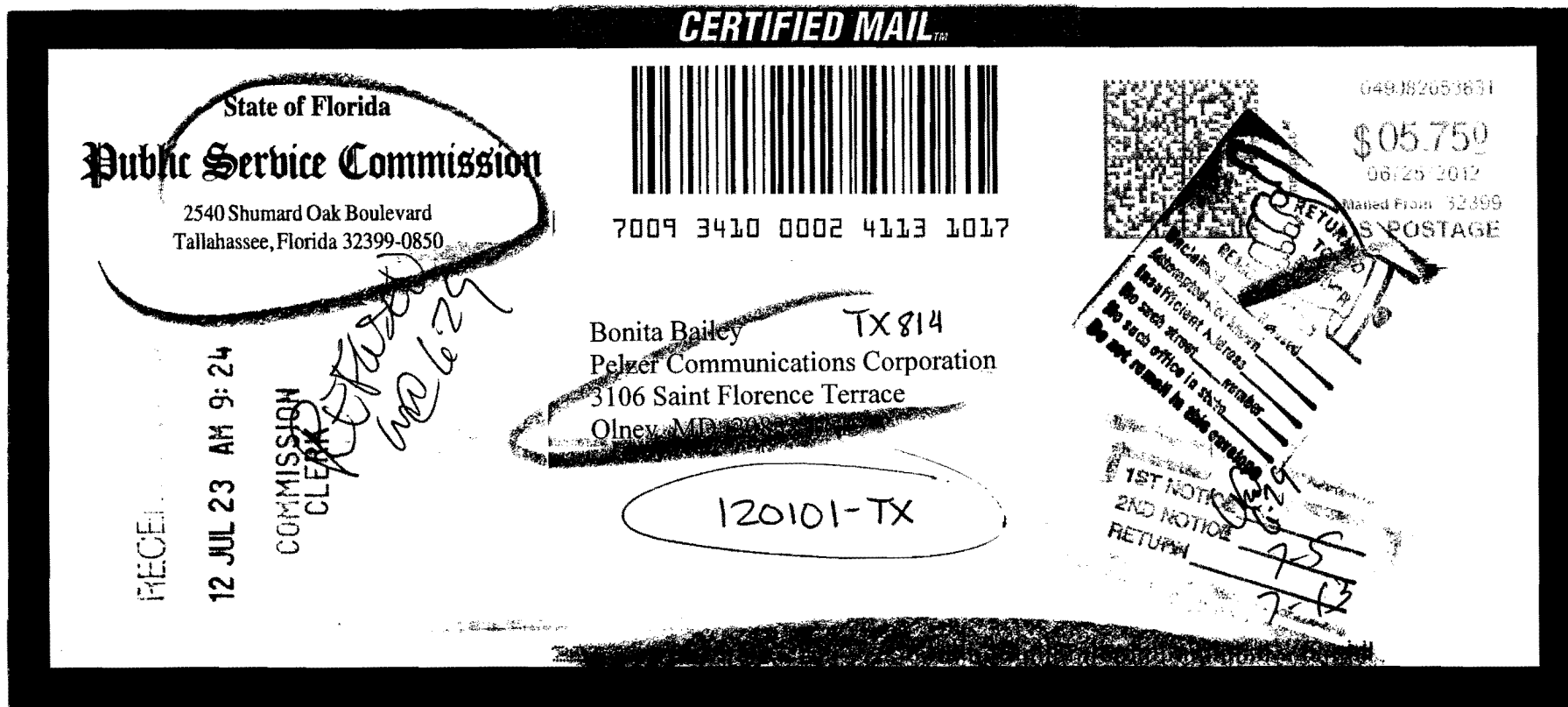

CONSUMMATING ORDER


BY THE COMMISSION:
