Q. 1) Does the application for the original wastewater certificate provide for and recognize that the residential realty being serviced by the wastewater facility, came with a wastewater connection and service as a part of an appurtenance to the land, and if not will PSC staff recommend that the Proposed Agency Action include such a provision.

Q. 2) Does the application for the original wastewater certificate provide that the Utility will not seek a rate increase predicated on the premise that the projected 80% of capacity has not been realized and that as a consequence petition for an increase in rates, and if the waste water certificate does not so provide, will the PSC staff recommend that the Proposed Agency Action include such a provision.
