RESOLUTION NO. 12-57

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA; ENCOURAGING THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO SUPPORT THE RIGHT OF PORT ORANGE RESIDENTS RELATING TO SMART METER INSTALLATION IN HOMES; REQUIRING HOMEOWNER PERMISSION PRIOR TO SUCH INSTALLATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as a result of additional public comment concerning smart meters during a city council meeting, the council has received additional clarity regarding the beliefs of certain residents of the city regarding smart meter related health, safety, privacy and financial concerns; and

WHEREAS, while the city council continues to take no position regarding the validity of the resident's concerns, the council is requesting that utility providers only install smart meters at the homes of residents who request them, or "opt in" to the smart meter program.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated as if fully stated herein as the findings of the City Council of the City of Port Orange, Florida.

Section 2. "Opt In" to Smart Meter Program. It is the position of the city council that given the concerns of some city residents regarding smart meters, applicable utilities and the Florida Public Service Commission should consider amending the smart meter installation program so that only residents who "opt in" or request participation in the program shall receive smart meters.

Section 3. Copy of Resolution. The City Council hereby directs the city clerk to provide a copy of the resolution to the Florida Public Service Commission.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
