Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby submits its Preliminary List of the Issues and Positions to be taken up at the hearing scheduled to commence on November 5, 2012 in the above docket.

GENERIC CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY ISSUES

ISSUE 1: What are the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2011 through December 2011?

Tampa Electric's Position: An over-recovery of \$597,093, including interest. (Witness: Bryant)

ISSUE 2: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2013 through December 2013?

Tampa Electric's Position: \$51,845,089. (Witness: Bryant)

ISSUE 3: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

<u>Tampa Electric's Position</u>: For the period January 2013 through December 2013 the cost recovery rates are as follows:

- 0.298 cents per kWh for Residential
- 0.284 cents per kWh for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service
- 1.06 dollars per kW for Full Requirement General Service Demand Secondary
- 1.05 dollars per kW for Full Requirements General Service Demand Primary
- 1.04 dollars per kW for Full requirement General Service Demand Subtransmission NUMBER DATE

ISSUE 4: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

<u>Tampa Electric's Position</u>: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January, 2013 through December, 2013. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2013, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2013, so that each customer is billed for 12 months regardless of when the factor became effective. (Witness: Bryant)

COMPANY SPECIFIC CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY ISSUES

ISSUE 5: What is the Contracted Credit Value for the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 rate riders for Tampa Electric Company for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

<u>Tampa Electric's Position</u>: In accordance with Order No. PSC-99-1778-FOF-EI, issued September 10, 1999 in Docket No. 990037-EI, Tampa Electric has calculated that, for the

forthcoming cost recovery period, January 2013 through December 2013, the Contracted Credit Value for the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 rate riders will be \$6.81 per kW. (Witness: Bryant)

ISSUE 6: What are the residential Price Responsive Load Management (RSVP-1) rate tiers for Tampa Electric Company for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

<u>Tampa Electric's Position</u>: For the period January 2013 through December 2013 the Residential Price Responsive Load Management (RSVP-1) rates are as follows:
