PREHEARING STATEMENT

Pursuant to the requirements of the Order on Procedure, Order No. PSC-12-0059-PCO-GU, Florida City Gas hereby submits its Prehearing Statement.

A. Known Witnesses

Florida City Gas intends to offer the testimony of Miguel Bustos filed on April 30, 2012 and September 11, 2012, and thereafter revised on September 18, 2012.

Miguel Bustos (Direct) Issues: 1 - 4

B. Known Exhibits

Florida City Gas intends to sponsor the following exhibits¹:

C. Basic Position

The Company's true-up amounts and conservation cost recovery factors as shown in Issues 1 through 4 are appropriate and should be approved.

D. – F. Issues

1. What are the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2011 through December 2011?

Florida City Gas: An end-of-period under recovery of \$1,076,076, for an adjusted net true-up reflecting an over-recovery of \$532,733, including interest.

2. What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2013 through December 2013?

Florida City Gas: A total of \$4,956,394.

3. What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

Florida City Gas: The appropriate factors are:

GS-1, GS-100, GS-220, RSG, CSG (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.14728
GS-600 (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.07814
GS-1200 (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.04650
GS-6k (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.03830
GS-25000 (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.03796
GS-60000 (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.03704
Gas Lights	\$0.07407
GS-120000 (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.02626
GS-250000 (Sales & Transportation)	\$0.02535

4. What should be the effective date of the conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

Florida City Gas: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2013 through December 2013. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2013 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2013, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.

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G. Stipulated Issues

Florida City Gas is not a party to any stipulations at this time, although it believes that it should be possible to reach a stipulation on each of the above issues as they relate to Florida City Gas.

H. Pending Motions

Florida City Gas has no pending motions or other matters requiring attention at this time.

None.


J. Compliance With Order on Procedure


