

Sebring has properly projected its costs and calculated its true-up amounts and conservation cost recovery factors. Those amounts and factors should be approved by the Commission.

D. STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Issue 1: **What are the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2011 through December 2011?**

Sebring's Position: \$15,563 (underrecovery).

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Issue 2: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2013 through December 2013?

Sebring's Position: \$25,485 to be recovered.

Issue 3: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2012 through December 2012?

Sebring's Position:

TS-1	\$0.11642/therm
TS-2	\$0.05881/therm
TS-3	\$0.04215/therm
TS-4	\$0.03494/therm

Issue 4: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

Sebring's Position: The conservation cost recovery factors should be effective for the period January 2013 through December 2013, and to billings thereafter until other conservation cost recovery factors are approved by the Commission.

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
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
