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**CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Moving to Item Number 7. It is my understanding that Mr. McDonald is on the line and will be available to answer questions, if necessary.

**MR. HARRIS:** Yes, sir. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

Larry Harris on behalf of the Office of General Counsel.

This is Docket 110305. It's a complaint by Mr. Edward McDonald against Tampa Electric Company. We're here today on a recommendation regarding a motion -- request for oral argument by Mr. McDonald, a motion for reconsideration, motion for stay of proceedings, motion to strike, and notice of filing a complaint. Staff recommends that oral argument be denied, and we recommend that the Commission not proceed with the motions filed by Mr. McDonald and instead issue -- the order would remain final.

Staff is available to answer any questions. And as you said, Mr. McDonald is on the phone and available to answer any questions the Commission might have.

**CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Thank you very much. I just want to make sure Mr. McDonald, Mr. McDonald understands

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that he's there to answer questions, if there are any questions that are posed to him.

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**MR. HARRIS:** I did convey that to him, yes, sir.

**CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Okay. Thank you. Commissioner Graham.

COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. This question, I guess, is to staff. Staff, this thing seems to be lingering on for quite a while. What can we do to bring this to closure so something else doesn't pop up again in another three more months and something else comes up in another three more months?

MR. HARRIS: Staff would suggest that an affirmative vote on staff's recommendation today should bring this to a landing. It's essentially recommending that all of the previous orders be made final, that Mr. McDonald has not stated a complaint upon which this Commission would take action. And, therefore, with reconsideration denied it would become final. I suppose Mr. McDonald could appeal that, but it would probably close the proceedings here.

**COMMISSIONER GRAHAM:** So if he chose to appeal that, then does that appeal go to a different court or does it come back here?

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MR. HARRIS: If he were able to appeal that, and I don't know that he is, but if he were, yes, it would go to the district court of appeal. COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: But so as far as we here at the PSC are concerned, this issue is just done after we, we move forward with this vote? MR. HARRIS: That is my understanding. Yes, sir.

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**COMMISSIONER GRAHAM:** Okay. Well, if there's nobody else, I'll move staff recommendation.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Second.

**CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** All right. It's been moved and seconded. Any further discussion or questions?

MR. McDONALD: Mr. Chairman? Mr. Chairman? CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Mr. McDonald.

**MR. McDONALD:** Yes. I'd like to address the Commission, if I may.
