On January 11, 2013, Pluris Wedgefield, Inc. (Pluris or Utility) filed its request for confidential classification for Document No. 00234-13. The document is the Utility's response to Staff's Fourth Data Request, Item No. 9, dated December 19, 2012. Certain information produced in response to Staff's Fourth Data Request consists of employees' name and title, base salary, overtime, raises, taxes, pension information, total compensation and contribution to 401(k) plans. The Utility claims the information is intended to be, and is treated by, Pluris as private and confidential, has not been disclosed externally, and has been strictly controlled internally. Staff has reviewed the documents and concurs with the Utility that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm the Utility's competitive business interests and would impair the ability of the Utility to contract for employees on favorable terms. Therefore, staff recommends that the Utility's request for confidential classification of Docket No. 00234-13 be approved.
