The purpose of the oral argument is to provide parties with an opportunity to present arguments regarding the question raised by Progress Energy Florida, Inc., Office of Public Counsel, Florida Industrial Power Users Group, PCS Phosphate, and Florida Retail Federation in their Joint Motion of the Parties to Resolve Disputed Case Issues.
