**P R O C E E D I N G S**

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2           **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** We will officially call  
3 this meeting to order at this time, and recognizing  
4 that today is the 20th take our daughters and sons  
5 to work day. And our theme this year, I guess the  
6 national theme is work in progress. So we have some  
7 future workers that are here today, and they are  
8 here in the audience, so if we have all the young  
9 people stand. And they represent the future of not  
10 only this agency but our state and our community  
11 overall. So we want to welcome them, and we hope  
12 that they enjoy seeing what their parents do --  
13 y'all can have a seat.

14           (Audience applause.)

15           **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** We certainly hope that as  
16 they spend some time with us today, they will sort  
17 of gain an understanding of what their parents do  
18 and how exciting the work of their parents is, and  
19 how they get to eat every day, and have a place to  
20 stay, and all of that.

21           So we thank everyone who was participating  
22 today. I know it's a little different than what we  
23 usually do. We usually have a full on program, but  
24 the fact that we have an agenda today changes  
25 things. But I think it creates an opportunity for a

1 different type of experience. So we thank all of  
2 those who are participating today in that.

3 With that, we are ready to move on to the  
4 other business of the day. And I think we are ready  
5 to entertain a motion, recognizing that Item Number  
6 3, there is a oral modification. And so after  
7 the -- after there's a motion for the items that are  
8 on move staff, we will entertain that and then move  
9 accordingly.

10 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Mr. Chairman, I  
11 understand that we have an oral modification on Item  
12 3.

13 **MS. BRUCE:** Yes. Commissioners, Sonica  
14 Bruce. Commission staff has on oral modification on  
15 Page 34 of the recommendation at the bottom of the  
16 page. In the section titled wastewater service  
17 availability charges, the plant capacity charge  
18 should be \$765 per ERC for residential customers and  
19 \$2.83 for all others. The main extension charge  
20 should be \$2,268 per ERC for residential customers  
21 and \$8.40 for all others. Thank you.

22 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Mr. Chairman, if  
23 appropriate I would move the staff recommendation  
24 for Items 1, 3 as modified, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8.

25 **CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** Thank you.

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It has been moved and seconded. Is there any further discussion or comments on any of these items?

Okay. Just a quick comment on Items 7 and 8, recognizing that there is a slight rate impact there, recognizing that all of those items are as a result of rules that are outside of our purview that the companies have to deal with to comply.

So all in favor say aye.

**CHAIRMAN BRISÉ:** All right. Thank you.

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
