ORDER AMENDING WATER AND WASTERWATER CERTIFICATES

BY THE COMMISSION:

Background

On February 2, 2013, Central Sumter Utility Company, L.L.C. (Central Sumter or Utility) filed an application with this Commission to amend Certificate Nos. 631-W and 540-S to extend service territory in Sumter County. Central Sumter is a Class B utility providing water service to approximately 1,755 customers and wastewater service to approximately 1,756 customers. The Utility's 2012 Annual Report indicates operating revenues of \$501,971 and a net income of \$357,667. The Utility's intent is to extend its certificated water and wastewater service areas as described in Attachment A.

Central Sumter's original water and wastewater certificates were granted in 2005.¹ There has been one certification amendment in 2012² to extend service area and to correct the name of the utility. We have jurisdiction pursuant to Section 367.045, Florida Statutes (F.S.).

Decision

The Utility's application to amend its authorized service territory was submitted in accordance to Rule 25-30.036, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The application contains proof of compliance with the noticing provisions set forth in Rule 25-30.030, F.A.C. No objections to the application were received and the time for filing such has expired.

The proposed service territory includes approximately 1,579 water equivalent residential connections (ERCs) and 1,421 wastewater ERCs. The area will consist primarily of commercial customers. It includes four parcels totaling approximately 177.11 acres, and these parcels are adjacent to the existing service territory. The application contains warranty deeds as evidence that the Utility owns the land upon which the Utility's water and wastewater treatment facilities are located. Adequate service territory maps and territory descriptions were also provided. The Utility's application included a statement indicating that Central Sumter is an affiliate of The Villages, Inc. (The Villages). The statement went on to say that The Villages is a real estate developing company that will develop the proposed amended territory, and provide the financial and operating support necessary for the Utility to be successful.

The Utility's water treatment plant has a permitted maximum daily capacity of 4.320 million gallons per day (mgd), and the projected maximum daily demand at build-out is 3.702 mgd. The wastewater treatment plant has a permitted annual average daily capacity of 1.60 mgd, and the projected annual average daily flow at build-out is 1.347 mgd. The build-out projections include both the existing and proposed service territory projected flows. The Utility stated in its filing that provisions have been made in the system design for existing lines to be extended into the proposed territory. As such, Central Sumter's facilities appear to be sufficient to provide service to the proposed territory. According to the application, the provision of water and wastewater services in the proposed service territory is consistent with the Sumter County Comprehensive Plan. The Department of Environmental Protection has stated that the Utility is presently in compliance with all applicable rules and regulations.

Based on the foregoing, we find it is in the public interest to amend Certificate Nos. 631-W and 540-S to include the territory as described in Attachment A, effective from the date of our decision, May 14, 2013. This Order shall serve as Central Sumter's amended certificates and shall be retained by the Utility. The Utility shall charge the customers in the territory added herein the rates and charges contained in its current tariff until a change is authorized by this Commission in a subsequent proceeding.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Central Sumter Utility Company, LLC's request to amend Certificate Nos. 631-W and 540-S to include the territory as described in Attachment A is in the public interest and hereby granted effective May 14, 2013. It is further

ORDERED that this Order shall serve as Central Sumter Utility Company, LLC's amended certificates and shall be retained by the Utility. The Utility shall charge the customers in the territory added herein the rates and charges contained in its current tariffs until a change is authorized by this Commission in a subsequent proceeding. It is further

ORDERED that this docket be closed.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Office of Commission Clerk, and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
