Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) requests confidential classification of certain highlighted information on Document No. 03033-13.

Staff has reviewed TECO's confidentiality request. Document No. 03033-13 contains information regarding the approval by TECO Energy Inc's Board of Directors for prospective equity infusions from the parent company TECO Energy Inc. to TECO which have not been made public. In staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in section 366.093 Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information in the context in which it is presented in Document No. 03033-13 be approved.
